Teaching Posts

A) Post Graduate Teacher (PGT) Educational and other qualifications Essential:

(i) Master's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/Institution's norms) in the following subject:

OR

Two years integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the following subjects with at least 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ Institution's norms).

- (ii) B.Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized University. However, if no candidate with B.Ed is available, then candidates without B.Ed. may be taken provided she/he has passed the qualifying degree with first class (60% marks or the equivalent grade.)
- (iii) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

Note: Candidates having Special B.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGT.

OR 'C' Level from 'DOEACC', Ministry of Information and Communication Technology and Graduation.

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(ii) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

Desirable:

- (i) Knowledge of Multi-Media and Web Technology, Computer Science and Informatics Practices.
- (ii) Working knowledge in Hindi.

B) Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) (Hindi / Sanskrit & English) Educational and other qualifications

Essential: (i) Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / institution's norms) in the subjects concerned / combination of subjects and as well as in aggregate.

OR

Four years integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms) in the subjects / combination of subjects concerned and as well as in aggregate.

The elective subjects / languages in the combination of subjects are as under:

- (iv) Proficiency in teaching in English medium (except for TGT (Hindi / Sanskrit)).
