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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 3. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 4. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 5. Bid reserved for Make In India products: : Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 . In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 6. Procurement under this bid is reserved for purchase from Micro and Small Enterprises whose credentials are validated online through Udyog Aadhaar for that product category. If the bidder wants to avail the reservation benefit, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service.
- 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 8. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

1) Pre-Qualification Criteria (PQC):

The Qualifying Criteria for this tender are as follows. The bids of tenderers which do not fulfil the Qualifying Criteria shall be summarily rejected.

Experience Criteria

Experience of having successfully completed similar works during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which application are invited should be either of the following:-

I. Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount e qual to **Rs.19.96** Lakhs.

or

II. Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to Rs.24.96 Lakhs.

or

- III. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs. 39.93** Lakhs.
- IV. Copy of completion/performance report from the organization where the relevant work is executed is to be enclosed. Submission of Work Order copy alone is not adequate. For the work executed (completed work) in UCI L the work Order copy is acceptable.
- V. Bidder who are seeking exemption on experience & turnover criteria, th ey must upload valid MSME/SSI/NSIC certificate (In specific field) in GeM-P ortal while submitting of technical part bid.

Note1: Bidders who are having a valid MSME certificate in the field related to "manufacturing/ supply/services shall be exempted from above criteria (ATC/GeM).

Similar works means "Cutting of grass and jungle/Nursery and Horticult ure work/ Sanitation work/Civil construction works/Civil maintenance works."

Financial Criteria:

Bidder must have achieved an average minimum financial turnover of Rs. 15.00 Lakhs or more during last three financial years ending on 31.03.202 3 (i.e., FY 2020-21, FY 2021-22 & FY 2022-23) including profit and loss account, necessary undertaking(if any) etc. along with technical bid.

2) SCOPE OF WORK:

Cutting & Disposal of wild grass/ bushes at Plant area, Boundary wall area, Township and Tailing pond area to a lead of 05 kms. arranging tractor with trolley by contractor at Tummalapalle plant area including labour, tools & tackles etc. as per direction of Engineer-in-charge.

List of machineries and tools and tackles to be arranged by contract agen cy to execute the work:

- 1. Deployed Dozer/ JCB as and when required
- 2. Deployed Roller as and when required
- 3. Tools & tackles such as billhook, pruning knife, sickle, grafting knife, pruning shear s, pruning saw etc.

A) Method of disposal: Disposal area shall be a low level area which shall be jointly decided by contract agency and UCIL at site location and the fre

quency of disposal shall be 1 time a week and as per directions of Engine er-in-charge.

The executing agency shall maintain measurements of work done and carr yout joint measurements with UCIL. UCIL shall except as otherwise stated ascertain and determine the value of the works done in accordance with the measurement recorded and the contracted rates for each such items of work.

Note: Contractors are advised to see the area get acquainted wit h the actual features of the area where work is to be executed an d get other related information before quoting their rates for carr ying out the work successfully.

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The scope of work also includes the following for which no extra payment will be made. Therefore, contractor may consider this while quoting their rate of other items as mentioned under bill of quantities for various item s of work

- A) Cleaning of site and leveling of location for construction works including u prooting of bushes and root vegetation.
 - B) Maintenance of the proposed area for which no payment will be ma de.
 - C) Contractor has to bring necessary equipments to execute the work near plant area and also transporting the materials to the various lo cations by vehicles as per directions of Engineer In charge
- D) The scope of work also includes the following for which no extra payment will be made. Therefore, contractor may consider this while quoting their r ate of other items as mentioned under bill of quantities for various items o f work.

The Contractor shall carry out and complete the said work in every respect in accordance with the Contract and with the direction of and to the satisfaction of the Corporation. The Corporation may in his absolute discretion and from time to time issue written instructions,

Details, directions and explanations, which are hereafter collectively referred to as UCIL's instructions in regard to:

1. The variation or modification of the design, quality or quantity of work

s or the addition or omission or substitution of any work.

- 2. Any discrepancy in the Schedule of Quantities and/or Specification.
- 3. The removal from the site of any material brought there on by the Contractor and the Substitution of any other material thereof.
- 4. The removal and/or re-execution of any works executed by the Contra ctor.
- 5. The dismissal of any person from works employed there upon.
- 6. Opening up for inspection of any work covered up.
- 7. Amending & making good of any defect.

3) Compensation for Delay:

I. If the Contractor fails to maintain the required progress in terms of the condition of this contract or to complete the work and clear the site on or before the contract or extended date/p eriod of completion, he shall, without prejudice to any other rig ht or remedy of the Corporation on account of such breach, pay as agreed compensation amount calculated as stipulated below or such similar amount as the contract value of the work for every week that the progress remains below that specified or that the work remain incomplete.

This will also apply to items or group of items for which separa te period of completion has been specified.

For this purpose the terms 'Contract Value' shall be the value at contract rates of the works as ordered

(a) Completion period (as originally stipulated) : @ 1 percent per week

not exceeding 6 m onths

(b) Completion period (as originally stipulated) : @ $\frac{1}{2}$ percent per week

Exceeding 6 months and not exceeding 2 years

(c) Completion period (as originally stipulated) : @ 1/4 percent per week

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Providing always that the total amount of compensation for delays to be p aid under this condition shall not exceed the under noted percentage of th e contract value of the item or group of items of work for which a separate period of completion is given.

- (a) Completion period (as originally stipulated) :10 percent not exceeding 6 months
- (b) Completion period (as originally stipulated): 7 ½ percent Exceeding 6 months and not exceeding 2 years
- (c) Completion period (as originally stipulated) : 5 percent Exceeding 2 years

The amount of compensation may be adjusted or set of against any sum p ayable to the Contractor under this or any other contract with the Corpora tion.

- 4) Completion Period: 24(Twenty Four) months from the date of commencement of work. (Date of commence of work will be reckoned 10 days after issue of written order or from the date of issue of work order).
- **5) Security Deposit:** The Contractor shall permit the Corporation at the time or making any payment to him for work done under the Contract to d educt such sums as will along with the amount of the Earnest Money alrea dy deposited amount to 10% on the gross amount of bill till the sums and deducted amount to the figure shown in Schedule-F.
- <u>6) Defects Liability Period:</u> There will be no defect liability period for this work.
- **7) Refund of Security Deposit:** 100% of security deposit will be released after completion period.
- **8) Variation:** Any individual item may vary up to any extent subject to gro ss variation of maximum ± 10 % (ten percent) of contract value. Contract or is liable to execute above variation at the same rate, terms and conditi ons stipulated in the contract.
- **9) Extension:** Completion period of contract is **24(Twenty Four) month s** from the date of commencement. The tenure/period may be extended u p to **03(three) months** (if the contract value is not consumed completely due to unforeseen reasons) further after completion of initial contract period with same rate, terms & conditions of the contract with mutual consent, if so deemed fit by UCIL and agreed by the contractor, as the nature of a warded work is as and when required basis and at discretion of the Engine er-in-charge.
- 11) Escalation: No escalation will be paid for this work.
- **12) Payment terms:** Running bill can be raised on the progress. Payment shall be made within 30days from date of certificate of bill by Engineer-incharge after necessary recoveries.
- **113) Agreement & Indemnity:** The tenderer shall execute the agreement & Indemnity with the UCIL in the proforma approved by the UCIL for the e xecution of the work, within 30(Thirty) days or as directed from the date o f issue of letter of intent/ work order on non-judicial stamp paper of requisite value (min. of 100/-), which shall be provided by the tenderer at his ow

n cost.

14) Personal protective equipment: All the required tools, tackles & sa fety items i.e helmet, gum boot/ safety shoes, hand gloves, dust mask, inc luding tools and tackles etc. for this work is to be arranged by the contractor at his own cost. All workmen engaged must wear PPE's while at work.

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Disclaimer/अस्वीकरण

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.

- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
