QUOTATION

Sub: Sanitaiton and Cleaning work at Mohuldlh Mines.

Dear Sir,

You are invited to offer sealed quotation for the subject work schedule of quantity in duplicate) in the enclosed schedule of quantity based on the terms and conditions given below: -

- 1. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:**
C. P. W. D SPECIFICATIONS for works, in general, shall be followed for execution of works.
- 2. FREE ISSUE MATERIALS: - All Consumable materials will be issued from UCIL Store/Civil site Store.**
- 3. SITE INVESTIGATION:**
The Tenderers are advised to visit the site to acquaint themselves as to the nature and location of the work, the general and local conditions particularly those bearing upon transportation, disposal, handling and storage of materials, availability of labour, water, electric power, road conditions, traffic density and also uncertainties of weather or similar physical conditions of the site, the formation and conditions of the ground, the character, quality and quantity of surface and sub-surface materials to be encountered, including sub-soil water levels the character of equipment and facilities needed preliminary to and during the progress of the work and all other matters which can be of in any way affect the work the cost thereof under the contract.
- 4. WATER AND ELECTRICITY:** Subject to availability, corporation shall supply water (for construction purpose) and electricity for lighting and construction purpose only at a suitable location near the working site on free of cost, any extension or distribution thereof, shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost. Any misuse/ wastage of the services provided shall be charged at a penal rate as decided by the Engineer-in-charge and no claim shall be entertained in the event of any failure on the part of "Corporation to provide such services".
- 5. GOVERNMENT LABOUR ACT:** The contractor has to follow strictly the Government Labour Act, which are and will be in force during the period of execution of work. All necessary arrangements for Labour's Security Insurances will have to be made by the contractor at his own cost.
- 6. CONTRACT LABOUR ACT:** According to provision of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act of 1970 and Contract (Regulation & Abolition) central rules, 1971, contractors engaging 20 or more contract labour on any day are required to obtain the license from the Regional Labour Commissioner. In the event of the breach of aforesaid conditions, the contractor shall be open for action as deemed fit by the concerned labour authorities of the State/Central Government.
- 7. TAX & DUTIES:** The quoted rate should be inclusive of all materials (except free issue materials) & including GST. Hence, no other taxes, duties etc will be paid extra, or any imposition of new Governmental taxes / duties during the contract execution etc. period.
- 8. The Contractor should quote their rates considering minimum wages of Un-Skilled/ Semi Skilled labourers as per notification of UCIL. In case of any increase in minimum wages, the same has to be paid by the Contractor.**

9. **PENALTY:**

- I) No penalty will be deducted for 05 daily deployments.
- II) If daily attendance less than 05 man/days @ Rs 500/- penalty will be deducted for each short fall attendance from monthly RA bill.

10. In case payment of labourers engaged for this work, has not been made on stipulated payment day, Corporation shall compel the contractor to stop the work besides taking other suitable steps to make the payment to the workers at risk and cost of the Contractor.

11. **SPECIFICATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED:** All work shall, unless specified otherwise, confirmed to the latest revision of relevant Indian Standard specifications and codes of practice. In case of any particular aspect not specifically covered the standards the standard practice as may be specified by Engineer shall be final and binding.

12. All the labour rules shall be followed strictly as per contract labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970. All registers, forms stipulated under Contractor Labour Act should be maintained by the contractor and to be furnished to the corporation before commencement of the work. In case of non-submission of above registers/forms to the corporation regularly, contractor will not be allowed to continue to do the work.

13. Safety precautions shall be maintained by the contractor during the execution of work. Safety appliances like helmet, gum boot, safety belt, goggles, hand gloves etc shall be provided to the workmen by contractor at their own cost.

14. ESIC workmen coverage for **07 Nos. workmen (minimum)** shall be obtained by the contractor for the workmen engaged at site and labour license, if applicable shall be obtained this work at their own cost for the whole period of the contract and shall be furnished to the corporation before commencement of the work without which contractor will not be allowed to start the work.

15. Successful tenderer must engage one experienced person at site during the entire working period for supervision of this work.

16. Contractor shall have to provide the facilities under the provision of Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 – Section – 16, 17, 18 and 19, Chapter – V – “Welfare and Health of Contract Labour”.

17. Quantity of an individual item may vary to any extent and be excluded altogether. Contractor will carry out all works up to a total variation of $\pm 10\%$ (Ten) on the contract price and all quoted rates shall remain firm within this limit.

18. In case of stoppage of work by local people/ Bandh or any other reasons no idle charges will be paid by corporation towards Labour, plant and Machinery etc. to the contractor for this work.

19. No any carriage/transportation for any material shall be paid by the department for this work. Contractor should quote their rates accordingly.

20. Unless specifically mentioned otherwise in the contract the tenderer shall quote for the finished items and shall provide for the complete cost towards labour materials, erection and dismantling of necessary scaffolding, levies all taxes, royalty, transport, storage, repairs, rectification, maintenance till handing over, revenue expenses, contingencies overheads profits and all incidental items not special work. In the event of the breach of aforesaid conditions, the contractor shall be open for action as deemed fit by the concerned labour authorities of the State/Central government.

21. **DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD:** Nil.

22. Contractors shall strictly abide by the security rules and regulations enforced by the owner time to time. The contractor shall provide proper identify cards, badges etc to his employees wherever directed by the engineer.

23. The 'Engineer' wherever appears in the contract shall mean 'Engineer-in-charge' of the work.

24. R.A. & final bill will be paid for this work.
25. E.P.F. & paid holidays shall be paid by the contractor as per norms.
26. The contractor shall prepare the wages sheet for his employees in duplicate, a copy of which shall be regularly submitted to the Engineer-in-charge.
27. The corporation, may for the any reason, ask the contractor to suspend the work, fully or partly and the contractor shall comply with same without having any claim whatsoever, for such suspension.
28. Contractor must quote their rates against all the items in Schedule of quantities supplied along with this tender. If any contractor fails to quote any of the items, they have to execute without any payment.
29. The Contractor / bidder or sub-contractor shall have Provident Fund Code Number.
30. All the Manpower requires to be deployed in this contract should enroll as members of Provident Fund and should be given the Universal Accounts Number (UAN).
31. While submission of bill the Contractor should submit certificates of all workers employed directly or indirectly by them are register for EPF and the due Contributions have been credited into their account.
32. The contractor should bring all the materials as per IS specification. All The materials should be approved by EIC before execution of work.
33. Necessary tools and plants should be kept at site; no extra cost will be paid for the same.
34. Quotations must be submitted in the enclosed schedule of quantity (original and two copies in Xerox of the same) duly signed along with seal of the agency. Duly filled quotations shall be submitted in a sealed envelope and to be deposited in the office of Manager (Pers.), Turamdih upto 29.10.2024 (12.00 Noon.) and will be opened on same day at 3.30 P.M at Turamdih.
35. All other terms and conditions shall be applicable as per General conditions of UCIL's tender norms.

Either in full or part thereof or to split up if necessary without assigning any reason whatsoever.
