

## Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2026/B/7671338-C1

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be  $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$ , subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.
2. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of URANIUM CORPORATION OF INDIA LIMITED payable at SBI, Jaduguda.  
Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
3. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of URANIUM CORPORATION OF INDIA LIMITED payable at SBI, Jaduguda.  
After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.
4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

### **The Pre- qualification criteria (PQC) to qualify in Techno commercial Part are as below:-**

1. The Bidder must have experience in similar nature of works in **last seven years** ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:-
  - a) One similar nature of work not less than 80 % of the estimated value of the work .  
Or
  - b) Two similar nature of work not less than 50 % of the estimated value of the work .  
Or
  - c) Three similar nature of work not less than 40 % of the estimated value of the work .
2. Minimum average annual financial turnover 30 % of the estimated value of the work for last 03(three) financial years and submission of duly audited copy of **Profit & Loss account statement** and **Balance Sheet** of financial years 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 by Chartered Accountant. UIDN number should be mentioned by Chartered Accountant.

3. The Bidder shall furnish a copy of **MSME/NSIC, GST, PF Registration Number, ESIC and Make in India (MII) compliance documents.**

4. Bidder must submit **Work Order and Work done or Work Completion Certificate** mentioned executed amount and date of completion in **last seven years** ending last day of month.

**5. Similar Works means:- “Experience in execution of same work with any Central/ State Govt. Organization / PSU/ Public Listed Company. Where same work mean supply & Installation of Fully Electronic Weighbridge of minimum 60 MT capacity or above, including associated civil works such as foundation, approach road, operator cabin, and electrical installation.**

6. **The tender documents shall be issued free of cost** to company/units registered with MSME/National Small Industries Corporation/Director of Industries of State, Cottage Industries approved by the State Authority or any other entity as may be specified by Govt. guidelines from time to time, after ensuring that the approval pertains to the class of item/works for which tender is floated.

Benefit for MSME owned by SC/ST will be applicable as per the Govt. guidelines. In case of Government undertaking / PSU, tender documents may be issued free of cost subject to approval of Competent Authority and it shall be mentioned in the tender document.

The tenders are to be uploaded at UCIL e-proc <http://ucil.gov.in/> and <http://bidplus.gem.gov.in> on or before due date fixed for receiving the bid. Physical submission of tender shall not be accepted.

Tenderers registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC)/Small Scale Industries (SSI)/Micro Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME), **for the tendered work will be exempted for submission of EMD and Tender Fee.**

Offers will be opened on due date as mentioned above by the Corporation's authorized representative(s) in the presence of Tenderers who are present.

Tenders received without earnest money are likely to be rejected. Tenderer shall enclose the EMD in form of DD/Bank Draft/BG in separate envelope and shall enclose the same in the envelope containing technical proposal.

The Corporation reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders in full or part and the tenderers shall be bound to perform the same at his quoted rates.

If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.

7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
