Name of Work: "Hiring of high-capacity mobile crane for sheave pulley bush replacement".

Terms & Conditions:

The rate shall be quoted by the party as per above schedule of items with GST considering the following Terms & Conditions for execution of entire scope of work mentioned above.

1. The time for completion of the work shall be **02 months** from the date of commencement. The work shall be executed on an urgent basis.
2. Party shall start the work without delay on stipulated date.
3. After completion of work party shall raise **One Final bill** with settlement. Payment shall be made within 30 days from the completion of entire scope of work on submission of Tax Invoice duly certified by Engineer-in-Charge by our Accounts Department.
4. The total amount of security deposit will be 10% of the awarded value of work i.e. contract price. Fifty percent of this amount (i.e. 5% of the contract price) shall have to be deposited as initial security deposit SD in the form of demand draft/ bankers cheque/ BG during execution of agreement or commencement of work at site whichever is earlier. Balance 5% shall be recovered from the R.A. Bills till the full amount of security deposit is recovered.

Acceptable Mode of payment of Initial Security Deposit: -

In properly executed DD/ Bank Guarantee issued by any Indian Nationalized/ Schedule Commercial banks in the approved format as enclosed herewith.

For Security deposit beyond Rs.5,000/- and up to Rs.1.00 Lakh: DAC/TDR/FDR/DD etc. may be deposited, issued from any Nationalized/schedule Commercial bank duly pleaded in favor of UCIL.

Return of 10% Security Deposit

The security deposit 5% of contract price shall be returned after issuance of Completion certificate from UCIL. Balance 5% amount which was recovered from R A bill shall be returned after expiry of defect liability period.

5. **Agreement shall be executed between party and UCIL for the above work.**
6. Party has to submit GST Registration Certificate, PAN Card, Bank details in support of this a cancelled cheque and details office address with contact no along with this quotation.
7. The quoted rate should be inclusive of Minimum Wages as per latest A.I. of UCIL considering PF, Bonus, Profit and GST.

8. Escalation: No extra payment will be made in any circumstances for this work except the quoted amount including GST.
9. The TDS on GST shall be recovered from the bill if applicable.
10. Variation and schedule of quantities: The quantities set out in the schedule of items are the estimated quantities of the permanent works only. The quantities may vary from those indicated in the tender documents due to the actual condition of the site or due to other reasons. The contractor shall carry out all the work up to a total variation of 10% on the contract price and up to any extend of individual items of schedule of quantities. All tendered rate shall remain firm within this limit and extra items may be included.
11. Safety precaution should be maintained during the execution of this work. Contractor should provide their own safety appliances like hand gloves, gumboot, safety helmet for this work.
12. All safety appliances like Gumboot, Helmet etc. will be arranged by the contractor.
13. A joint record shall be maintained by the contractor duly certified by Engineer-in-charge or his authorized representative for each item of works.
14. In case of stoppage of work by local people/Bandh or any other reasons, no idle charges will be paid by corporation towards Labour, Plant and Machinery etc. to the contractor for this work
15. Working hours: The work shall normally be carried out from 7.00 am to 06.00 pm on all working days.
16. Defect liability period: 12 Months.
17. **Liquidated Damages (LD)** shall be levied where reasons are attributable to supplier / contractors for delays in execution of purchase order/ contract. LD shall be levied @0.5% per week or part thereof on the value of unfinished supply/work order for each week of delay subject to a maximum of 5% of the total value of contract (excluding Taxes and Duties).
18. **Vehicle certificates requirements**
 1. Tax registration
 2. Fitness certificate
 3. Vehicle tax
 4. Pollution certificate
 5. Insurance
 6. Hook & rope test from any authorized unit for conducting such tests.
 7. Load test

Trial test will be taken at the site as per the requirement of contract.

Contractor shall be responsible for the lowering & lifting of sheave pulley safely & in good condition without any damage.
19. **Driver certificate requirements**

1. Valid authorization certificate from RTO and certificates from responsible agencies.

2. Crane operator should have minimum 10 years of experience.

Hiring will be for 02 days only but since the schedule for replacement of bush of sheave pulley is for 06 days the contractor will have to keep the crane available on call basis as when required by EIC.

20. The following examination committee will examine and verify the crane competency for the deployment of a mobile crane for the replacement of bush of sheave pulley.

The committee will also examine all the statutory documents related to the mobile crane.
