7) **Deviation of Order Quantity:** Up to 10% variations in the execution of purchase order of the total order value for sanctioned order value is allowed without issue of amendment / revision in the purchase order.

#### 8) <u>DISPUTE RESOLUTION MECHANISM AND JURISDICTION</u>:

- a. **CONCILIATION**: Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract, any disputes or differences whatsoever, which are to be settled amicably between the parties with their authorized representatives, shall be resolved through conciliation.
- b. **MEDIATION**: Any disputes or differences, which are not settled amicably through conciliation, then either of the parties, may approach for mediation to settle under mediation Act, 2023. The procedure is to be followed as prescribed in the Mediation Act, 2023 am ended from time to time.
- c. **AMRCD**: Any disputes or differences between the parties are not settled amicably with conciliation and/or Mediation, then such disputes or differences shall be resolved throu gh Administrative Mechanism for Resolution of CPSEs Disputes (AMRCD).
